



The Need for a Circular Economy Approach


The CleanBC Roadmap to 2030 aims to put B.C. on the path to net-zero emissions by 2050.

- The Climate Action Secretariat and Environmental Protection Division are working together to document the circular economy transition taking place in B.C.





